<div>OFFICIAL ABSENTEE/PROVISIONAL/EMERGENCY BALLOT</div> <div>OFFICIAL REPUBLICAN PARTY PRIMARY AND NONPARTISAN GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA MAY 19, 2020</div> <div><p>To vote, blacken the Oval (●) next to the candidate of your choice. To vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, manually WRITE his or her name in the write-in section and blacken the Oval (●) next to the write-in section. If you desire to vote YES or NO for a PROPOSED QUESTION, blacken the corresponding Oval (●). Use only blue or black pen or pencil.</p><p>Do not vote for more candidates than the number allowed for each specific office. Do not cross out or erase. If you erase or make other marks on the ballot or tear the ballot, your vote may not count.</p><p>If you change your mind or make a mistake, you may return the ballot by writing "Spoiled" across the face of the ballot and return envelope. You may then mail the spoiled ballot back to your county board of registrars, and you will be issued another official absentee ballot. Alternatively, you may surrender the ballot to the poll manager of an early voting site within your county or the precinct to which you are assigned. You will then be permitted to vote a regular ballot.</p><p><i>"I understand that the offer or acceptance of money or any other object of value to vote for any particular candidate, list of candidates, issue, or list of issues included in this election constitutes an act of voter fraud and is a felony under Georgia law." Chan Caudell (Incumbent)</div><div><input type="radio"/></div></div><div>Write-in</div></div> <div><div>For Judge of the Probate Court (Vote for One)</div><div><div><input type="radio"/> Cary Brown</div><div><input type="radio"/> Carlton Hobie Jones, III</div><div><input type="radio"/></div></div><div>Write-in</div></div>	<div><div>SPECIAL ELECTION RABUN COUNTY</div><div><div>The Continuation of a One Percent Sales and Use Tax for Educational Purposes (Vote for One)</div><div>Shall a special one percent sales and use tax for educational purposes be continued in Rabun County for a period not to exceed twenty (20) calendar quarters beginning upon expiration of the sales and use tax for educational purposes presently in effect, and for the purpose of raising not more than \$22,500,000 of net proceeds by said tax, which shall go to the School District for the purpose of (i) adding to, renovating, repairing, improving, and equipping existing school buildings and school system facilities, including athletic and fine arts facilities, (ii) acquiring miscellaneous new equipment, fixtures and furnishings for the school system, including technology equipment, security equipment, band equipment, textbooks, electronic instructional media and other instructional materials, (iii) acquiring school buses and transportation and maintenance equipment, (iv) acquiring, constructing and equipping a new agriculture education farm, and (v) acquiring real estate and conducting site preparation of real estate for school district purposes, including but not limited to for use as the future location of the agriculture education farm, and (vi) making payments under the Installment Sale and Use Agreement with Rabun County Building Authority for the purchase of an elementary school (the maximum aggregate amount of such payments not to exceed \$3,600,000), with the maximum cost of the projects described in items (i) (vi) payable from said tax being \$22,500,000, (vii) paying any general obligation debt of the School District issued in conjunction with the continuation of said sales and use tax, and (viii) paying expenses incident to accomplishing the foregoing. If the continuation of the tax is approved by the voters, such vote shall also constitute approval of the issuance of general obligation debt of Rabun County School District in the principal amount of \$8,000,000 for the purposes of the Rabun County School District described in items (i) -(v) and (viii) above and for the purpose of payment of a portion of the interest on such debt.</div><div><div><input type="radio"/> YES</div><div><input type="radio"/> NO</div></div></div></div>
